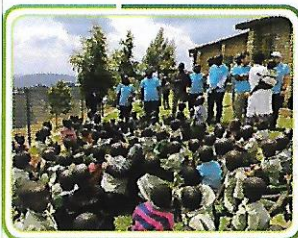


The prevention of infection diseases through hand and oral hygiene education, prevention of premature death through the education of road safety to students, all serve as important approaches for public health.



NPO TER is operating not only in Kigali but also in upcountry areas. Therefore, a project was started in Miyove Early Childhood Development Center (ECD) and its surrounding communities where direct nutrition support and health examination are provided to Children in that ECD. Furthermore, community empowerment and economic growth initiatives are implemented together with the behaviour change activities and vocational skills trainings provided to community members. Let us highlight that the beneficiaries are historically marginalized people (HMPs) as well as their neighbors

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Future Plan

In the future, NPO TER is planning to continue its activities based on the solid experience of more than 18 years in operations in Rwanda.

The much focus will be put on strengthening the community economic capacity for sustaining themselves, supporting education of children from poor families of ubudehe category 1 & 2, carrying out health examination to all schooling children in the schools of operations, promoting maternal and child health as a new strategy to combat malnutrition and promote good parenting.

A good partnership with local government and other NGOs intervening in the same sector will be also maintained

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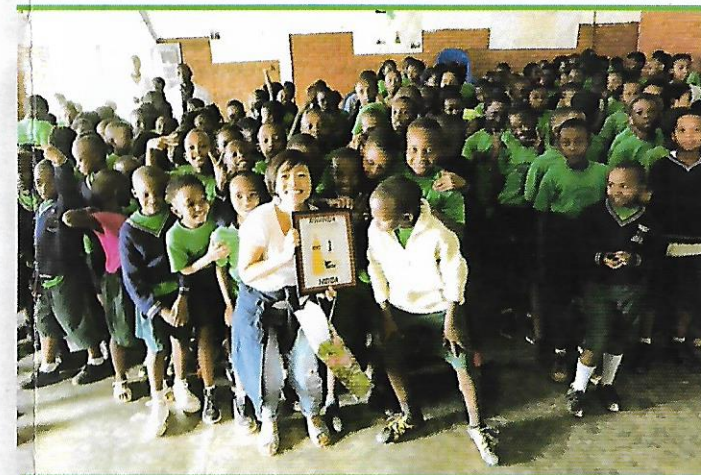

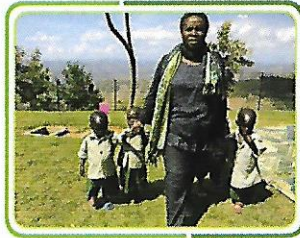


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Background

NPO Think About Education in Rwanda (NPO TER) is a non-profit organization founded in Fukushima-Japan in 2000 by a Rwandese lady who was committed to improve child education and health in Rwanda after the Genocide against the Tutsi in 1994.



NPO TER is also registered to operate locally in Rwanda as an international non-governmental organization under the law no 05/2012 of 17/02/2012 and with registration no 049/RGB/18.

Structure

From General assembly to the executive team, NPO TER exercises its functions with transparency, compassion and integrity by implementing the plan set and respecting structures as well as clear guidelines. The organisation is legally represented by the President of Board who is elected for a period of 2 years renewable. The Daily activities in Rwanda are performed by the Country Director who oversees the implementation of annual plans and reports to the Board via the General Secretariat based in Japan. All policies and procedures are approved by the Board of Directors and the latter informs the general assembly.

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Vision

Strengthening the Rwandan communities in particular and African in general through the implementation of joint or individual actions. This is achieved by using available and appropriate means in contributing to (1) achieving the good welfare of the population especially schooling children; (2) improving the quality of education; (3) innovating adapted solutions to newly identified needs toward good education and health.

Objectives

The organisation objective is to contribute towards peace and development in Rwanda by providing educational and health opportunities for Rwandan children who are both physically and mentally affected after Genocide against the Tutsi and giving them various types of education support which enables them to enjoy their healthy life and live free from any restrictions.

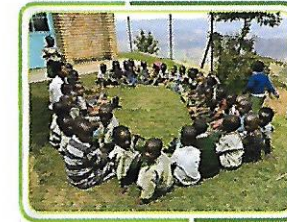
Activities

The objectives are achieved through implementation of the following activities:

- » International cooperation activities,
- » Activities for human rights protection and peace promotion,
- » Activities for children's health and education
- » Activities for promotion of culture, art and sport.
- » Activities related to the promotion of social business, to support vulnerable children accessing good education and health services.

Achievement

NPO TER has been always present in Rwanda to work with the government for achieving some of the national goals especially those related to the strengthening of education sector and School health. This was the key cornerstone to the success of education for all but also strengthened civil society and government partnership.



In this framework, the Umuco Mwiza Primary school was established at Bibare cell, Kimironko sector in Gasabo District. The school serves as model of the implementation for some of the national policies including school feeding, school health program, STEM promotion among others.

The School health Program was extended to other schools such as Kimironko I, Kimironko II. And



Kibagabaga Primary School through school feeding and school health program respectively. This includes but not limited to early detection, treatment and prevention of non-communicable diseases

(NCDs) through school health examination conducted by school nurses and doctors. The school feeding program to prevent malnutrition, prevention of early and unwanted pregnancy among schooling children through sexual and reproductive health activities are also vital.

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
